Garnet C. Rainey, Angeleno Attorney, Dies

Garnet C. Rainey, 47; Los Angeles attorney, died early yesterday at his home 8334 Marmont Lane, following an attack of coronary thrombosis he suffered during the night.

. At his bedside was his widow Marjorie, who is the president of the Los Angeles Junior League.

Mr. Rainey, born in Sah Jacinto, attended Los Angeles High School and received his A.B. degree at Stanford University. In 1916 he went overseas with a Stanford unit of the French Ambulance Corps and when America entered the war transferred to the United States Army.

After the armistice Mr. Rainey attended Christ Church College of Cambridge University in England, studying law, and finished his legal studies at the University of Southern California.

He entered practice in Los Angeles 22 years ago and in 1927 was married to Marjorie Hamlin, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Ralph Hamlin. Rev. George Davidson of St. John's Episcopal Church, who married the couple, will officiate at funeral services for the attorney Monday at Forest Lawn Memorial Park.
