ORDINANCE No. 4921

(New Series)

An ordinance amending and re-numbering Sections 24 and 48 of Ordinance No. 2472 (New Series) to be Sections 7.5 and 31.5 respectively, changing the name of Venice Township to Culver Township on July 1, 1947.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 24 of Ordinance No. 2472 (New Series), entitled "An ordinance dividing the County of Los Angeles into townships and establishing and describing the boundaries thereof," adopted May 28, 1934, is renumbered to be Section 7.5 and amended by amending the first paragraph to read:

Sec. 7.5. CULVER TOWNSHIP.

Culver Township hereby established shall consist of all that part of the County of Los Angeles within the following described boundaries:

Section 2. Section 48 of said Ordinance No. 2472 (New Series) is renumbered to be Section 31.5 and amended to read:

Sec. 31.5. The Justices' Court of Culver Township is the same court as was formerly called the Justices' Court of Venice Township and shall continue to be the successor of the Justices' Courts of Venice Township, Talamantes Township, Arnaz Township, and Chavez Township heretofore existing.

Section 3. The amendments and renumbering made by Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance shall become operative on, but not before, July 1, 1947.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after the date of its adoption, and prior to the expiration of fifteen days from the passage hereof shall be published once in the Culver City Star-News, a newspaper printed and published in the County of Los Angeles,
